If you are not sure whether used parts can be refitted, always fit new parts.




-> Fig.1 Gearshift mechanism trim in vehicles with manual gearbox





Fig.:1 Detaching connector for telephone





Fig.3 Removing cover of centre console

1.1 - Contact corrosion

Contact corrosion can occur if non approved fasteners are used on the vehicle (bolts, nuts, washers etc.).

For this reason. all the fasteners used in production are specially treated. These components can be identified by their greenish surface finish.

In addition to this, all rubber and plastic parts and all adhesives are made of non-electrically conductive materials.

If you are not sure whether used parts can be refitted, always fit new parts.

Important

- Use only genuine Audi A8 Parts.
- Accessories must be approved by AUDI AG.
- Damage resulting from contact corrosion is not covered by the warranty.

- Tensioner cable must not be kinked or bent more than 270°.
- Belt tensioner components must be neither opened nor repaired. Always use new components only.
- Belt tensioner units that have been dropped from a height of more than 50 cm, that are defective or that are
 damaged must not be fitted in vehicles

 damaged must all the fitted of the data and the data
- Belt tensioner units which are mechanically damaged (dents, fractures) must be replaced.
- Belt tensioner units must be fitted immediately after they are taken out of their transport containers.
- The belt tensioner unit must be replaced in its transport container when work is interrupted.
- Never point open end of belt tensioner at another person.
- Always wash hands after handling belt tensioners which have been activated.
- Storage and transportation are subject to the legislation for explosive substances.
- It is not permitted to leave the belt tensioner unit unattended.
- The belt tensioner unit must not be treated with grease, cleaning agents or similar.
- The belt tensioner unit must not, even for a short time, be exposed to temperatures above 100 °C, sparking or naked flame.

2.4 - Disposal of pyrotechnic belt tensioners


-> Fig.3 Anchorage point, seat frame


-> Fig.5 Attaching upper B-pillar trim to belt height adjuster


-> Fig.2 Anchorage point centre (left) floor panel





Fig.:2 Fitting right reinforcement

3 - Checking seat belts

3.1 - Checking seat belts

Important

After every accident the seat belt system must be inspected systematically. If damage is determined when inspecting the check points, customer must be informed regarding necessity of changing belts.

Check points:

- Check belt strap
- Check belt retractor (locking action)
- Visual inspection of belt buckle
- Functional test of belt buckle
- Check belt guides and latch plate
- Check securing parts and anchorage points

Note:

If customer refuses to have a damaged seat belt replaced, appropriate note should be made.

3.2 - Checking child seat restraint function for additional child seats

Passenger seat belt 07.96 ä, rear seat belts 07.95 ä

- The complete belt assembly (including B-pillar trim) must be fitted when checking this function.
- Activation of restraint function:
 - Pull out belt as far as possible.
- Function:
 - The belt should retract with an audible noise.
 - If the belt retraction is then stopped, it should not be possible to pull the belt out again until the function is deactivated.
- Deactivation:
 - Allow the belt to retract as far as the last 100 mm (approx.).
 - Restraint function must be deactivated at the latest when last 100 mm are reached. The belt then reassumes its normal function.

3.3 - Checking belt fastened sensor for rear left and right belts with belt tensioner 07.96 ä

4 - Airbag safety precautions

4.1 - Airbag safety precautions

4.2 - Safety precautions when working on airbag

- Testing, removing, installing and repair work may only be performed by qualified personnel.
- Do not test with a test lamp, voltmeter or ohmmeter.
- The airbag system may only be checked with fault reader V.A.G 1551/1552 and when installed. An exception
 is the self-cancelling ring with slip ring.
- Always disconnect power supply when working on the airbag system. Detach battery earthing strap/cable, cover over negative terminal. No waiting period is required after disconnecting the battery.
- There must be no-one in the vehicle when the battery is being connected.
- Airbag components must neither be opened nor repaired. Always use new components.
- The interval for replacing the airbag units no longer applies.

Always observe the following sequence when replacing an airbag unit:

1 - Remove old airbag unit and place down with padding facing upwards; with head airbag observe procedure for head airbag => Page 91.

2 - Take new airbag unit from transport container and store with padding facing upwards; with head airbag observe procedure for head airbag => Page 91.


3 - Immediately place old airbag unit into transport container.

- 4 Install new airbag unit into vehicle.
- The airbag units should be installed immediately after removing them from their transport containers.
- If work is interrupted, the airbag unit should be replaced in its transport container.
- The airbag units must not be left unattended.
- Airbag units which have been removed must stored with the padding facing upwards with exception of head airbag => Page 91.
- Airbag units which are dropped on a hard surface or are damaged must not be used.
- The airbag unit must not be treated with grease, cleaning agents or similar, and must not, even for a short time, be exposed to temperatures above 100 °C.
- Airbag units which were not triggered must be marked and be sent back to manufacturer for disposal (use transport containers for airbag units).
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4.3 - Additional safety precautions for side airbag

 The side airbags are subject to the same safety precautions as the driver's and front passenger's airbags as well as the following.



- -> Only fit genuine seat and backrest covers released for use by AUDI AG with side airbag (can be seen from airbag label attached on cover -1-).
- No extra covers should be fitted over the backrests, as this would impair the function of the side airbags.
- Seat cushions, mats or similar which would impair the function of the seat occupied sensor and airbags must not be used.

Note:


Seat-occupied sensor mat is not fitted in driver's seat.

- In vehicles with no seat heating, the seats are fitted with dummy seat heating elements (heating element with no wire).
- The foam upholstery in the backrest must not be cut away in the vicinity of the side airbag.
- The interval for replacing the airbag units no longer applies.
- If the seat cover fabric is damaged (tears, burn marks, etc.) in the vicinity of the side airbag, the cover must be replaced for safety reasons, as otherwise the side airbag will not inflate properly.
- No repairs may be performed on the backrest cover fabric near the side airbag (original fabric has special thread and exactly defined seams).
- Never use upholstery needles or poke any other sharp objects through the seat cover fabric in the vicinity
 of the airbag and sensor mat.
- When installing, ensure seam for side airbag is straight.

- All upholstery clips (metal and plastic clips) must be replaced.
- Use only genuine upholstery clips.
- When installing, all upholstery clips must be fitted in the same positions as the original ones.
- Always renew backrest upholstery after side airbag has been triggered.
- All damaged components must be replaced after an accident. The original airbag unit can still be used if no signs of damage are found.
- If side airbag units are replaced, remove airbag number sticker from the new unit and stick it over the old one on the seat pan.

4.4 - Additional safety precautions for head airbag


- The head airbags are subject to the same safety precautions as the driver's and front passenger's airbags.
- Before installing a visual check for damage on the trims must be carried out.
- Trim must not be repaired (upper A-pillar trim, upper B-pillar trim, upper C-pillar trim, narrow D-pillar trim and trim D-pillar).
- When installing, ensure that trims are fitted securely.






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- Take care not to kink head airbag module.
- When performing repairs behind head airbag always remove entire module (avoid partial detachment and kinking).
- -> Following removal of airbag modules -1- the front part (of A-pillar) must be suspended from clamp -2- of clamp type clip -3- for storage and transportation.



- -> Following removal place head airbag modules -1- in container in the shape of a loop or on a clean flat surface (on blanket or in boot).
- After body repairs in the vicinity of the head airbag the body must be checked for welding splashes, deformation or abrasion (compare to opposite side).
- Always hold head airbag module securely.



- -> Always fold head airbag modules -1- into a loop and only grasp hold of gas generator (with thumb pointing in direction of electrical connection).
- Always keep one hand on plastic housing.
- Do not twist, turn, knot, throw, pull, hang, pinch, press or clamp head airbag module.
- If contamination such as oil, grease, paint and solvents is absorbed into fabric always replace module.

4.5 - Replacing airbag units after accident

Accident with airbag/belt tensioner triggering up to and including airbag 7.

The control unit for airbag must be replaced every time an airbag/belt tensioner has been triggered.

Accident involving airbag/belt tensioner triggering with airbag 8 (introduced as of date of manufacture 10.98).

Notes:

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For vehicles with airbag 8 the display shows Airbag front + side or Airbag front + head.

The control unit for the airbag can be used for up to three side/head airbag and/or belt tensioner deployments.

The fault display "Control unit defective" will appear after third deployment.

Airbag control unit must be replaced:

- If driver/passenger airbag is deployed.
- If housing is damaged.
- In the event of tunnel deformation within 200 mm. radius of control unit.
- After airbags have been triggered three times.

Always exchange the following:

All triggered airbag units.

Additionally, if passenger's airbag has been triggered:

- Airbag flap and frame (Do not bend deformed frame back into shape); dash panel, if damaged.
- Lateral acceleration sensor if floor pan around sensor has been deformed.

Additionally, if driver's airbag has been triggered:

- Self-cancelling ring with slip ring.
- Lateral acceleration sensor if floor pan around sensor has been deformed.

Additionally, if side airbag has been triggered:

- Lateral acceleration sensor on side where airbag has been triggered.
- Backrest upholstery.
- Backrest cover.
- Non-triggered lateral acceleration sensor if floor pan around sensor has been deformed.

Additionally, if head airbag has been triggered:

- Lateral acceleration sensor on side where airbag has been triggered.


- -> Fig.1 Unscrewing airbag unit




Fig.:1 Gas generator at D-pillar





Fig.:2 Attachment of head airbag at B-pillar




Fig.:4 Detaching connector for head airbag

In addition to this, all rubber and plastic parts and all adhesives are made of non-electrically conductive materials.








Fig.:1 Detaching guard strip from roof
