
Repairing passenger airbag Removing and installing passenger airbag unit on RHD vehicles 07.96 ä


- 1. Airbag guide
- 2. Bolt 5 Nm
 - **♦** 2 off



3. Passenger's airbag unit

- ◆ Removing:
- In vehicles with encoded radio/radionavigation system (RNS) Refer to code; if necessary, establish.
- Detach battery earthing strap/cable, cover over negative terminal.

- Open glove compartment.
- Unscrew glove compartment frame.
- Pull glove compartment frame backwards out of guides.
- Detach
 connector for
 glove
 compartment
 light; leave
 Bowden
 cable of lock
 connected.
- Lay aside glove compartment in passenger's footwell.




- Unscrew 4
 bolts -Item
 4- of airbag unit.
- Release and detach orange connector -Item 8-.
- Remove airbag unit downwards and lay down with cushioned side facing upwards.
- Install in reverse order, note the following:
- Switch ignition on.
- Connect

battery.

4. Bolt - 9 Nm ♦ 4 off



5. Bolt with washer - 5 Nm

- For retaining frame
- ◆ 2 off
- Replace retaining frame after triggering of passenger's airbag

6. Bolt - 9 Nm

- For retaining frame
- ◆ 4 off
- Replace retaining frame after triggering of passenger's airbag

7. Red connector

◆ Must not

- be disconnected from airbag unit -Item <u>3</u>-
- If connector has been detached airbag unit is defective and must be replaced

8. Orange connector

 Installation position: At top in dash panel opening for glove compartment

Notes:

◆ After connecting the battery, please ensure that the vehicle accessories (radio, clock, electric window lifters) are checked according to workshop manual and/or operating instructions.

=> Electrical System; Repair group 27; Battery

◆ If the fault warning light (K 75) for airbag signals a fault after assembly the fault memory must be erased and again be interrogated by using fault reader V.A.G 1551.

=> Body Self-diagnosis; Repair group 01
