
Removing and installing B-pillar trim

- Cross-head screw -0.5 Nm
- ◆ 2 offThree-point seat belt
- Upper B-pillar trim
 - Removing:

 Remove

 lower B-pillar

 trim -Item <u>4</u>-.
 - Remove front grab handle and coat hook =>
 - Page <u>70-31</u>. • – Unclip upper Apillar trim in rear area.
 - Unscrew seat belt from seat
 => Fig.<u>69-16</u>.
 - – Remove cross-head screws -Item <u>1</u>- and -Item <u>7</u>-.



- Ease three point seat belt
 -Item <u>2</u>- out of B-pillar trim.
- ◆ Installing:
 Assemble
 B-pillar trim
 with height
 adjuster -Item
 8- as shown

Note:


Do not press button for manual height adjustment when installing.

> − Clip in Bpillar trim

twice at both front and rear of B-pillar.

Notes:

- Manual belt height adjustment mechanism must be heard to engage in all 5 positions
- After being actuated button must always return to upper position.



- Lower B-pillar trim
 - ◆ Removing:
 Unclip front sill panel trim => Page <u>70-</u>
 - $\frac{46}{0}$.
 - lower C-pillar trim at transition to B-pillar trim.
 - – Remove clips -Item <u>5</u>-.
 - Lift trim slightly and detach
 - connectors.Detach trim
 - downwards.

 - $\circ \diamond 2 \text{ off}$
- B-pillar
